

TODAY’S THEME

Trinitarian theology shows that the nature of God is relational and communal. In relationship we live and move and have our being with God and with one another. But because the Christian Trinity is a fourth-century construct, we should not expect these texts to illuminate Trinitarian theology. We can, however, use Trinitarian theology as a lens to view these texts. While the first creation story focuses on the goodness of creation, it begins with God (v. 1), Spirit (v.2) and word (v.3), and ends with God creating human beings in God’s (“Our”) likeness. The psalmist continues with the blessings of creation. The letter to Corinth speaks of the grace of Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit. Finally, Matthew’s Gospel issues Christ’s great commission: to make disciples of all nations and to baptize in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
